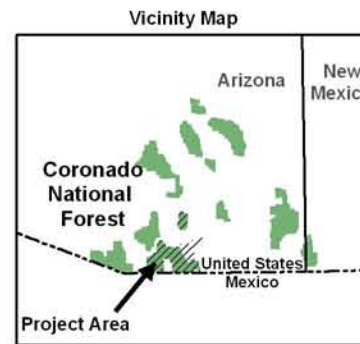

Ecological Units (EU) Within Huachuca Firescape Boundary	EU Acreage (Total)
<b>EU 1</b> Low gradient riparian system	130
<b>EU 2</b> Chihuahuan desert scrub, mostly limey or saline alluvial fans or terraces	16,655
<b>EU 3</b> Grasslands on dissected alluvial fans and plains. Includes a limited number of moderate gradient, relatively narrow sycamore-dominated riparian systems	49,295
<b>EU 5</b> Mostly oak savanna (with some oak woodlands on microsites), dissected alluvial fans	56,695
<b>EU 6</b> Oak savanna and open woodlands on granite hills	26,140
<b>EU 7</b> Oak savanna and woodland, volcanic hills and low mountains	49,415
<b>EU 8</b> Oak savanna and woodland granite mountains	23,155
<b>EU 9</b> Grass-chaparral and oak savanna on limestone-dominated hills and low mountains	41,265
<b>EU 10</b> Oak-pine woodland, limestone mountains. Includes some pine-oak woodland and mixed conifer on steep north aspects and canyons	20,455
<b>EU 11</b> Pine-oak woodland on granitic hills and low mountains	17,645
<b>EU 12</b> Mixed conifer, pine, and pine-oak woodlands on high elevation limestone and quartzite-dominated mountains	29,360
<b>EU 13</b> Sensitive higher gradient streams (line segments) nested within EUs 5, 10, 11 and 12	23 (miles)
<b>EU 14</b> Dominantly mesquite grasslands associated with granite influenced, often dissected alluvial fans	51,255
<b>EU 15</b> Grass-chaparral, grassland and oak woodland, limestone - dominated mountains	25,435
